

District Conference Weather Procedures

Our first priority is for the safety of all conference participants.

If the conference is held during a school day and there is inclement weather, each school should plan to attend the conference unless their school is closed that day. If more than half of the schools are closed on the day of the conference, then the conference will be canceled.

If the conference is held on a non-school day and there is inclement weather, The State Director will consult with the conference coordinator and school administration of the school hosting the conference to determine if the conference should be canceled.

Michigan DECA will email all advisors if the conference is canceled. If an email reply is not received within 30 minutes of the email, then a text will be sent announcing the cancellation. If there is no reply within 30 minutes then a call will be placed.

If a school does not attend because they are closed or if the conference is canceled, then Michigan DECA will determine who will advance on to the State Conference based on the online examination score. Individuals need to keep in mind that because of the other conferences taking place this time of year, that this information could take a couple of days to determine and distribute to the affected schools.
